RE German-African Innovation Incentive Award

Dear Sir or Madam,

Research and innovation are drivers of economic and societal development. In recent years, many African countries have been demonstrating a strong dynamism in the areas of knowledge generation and economic growth. Germany is greatly interested in cooperation with African partners in order to develop Africa's innovative potential in joint research and innovation projects and encourage sustainable economic growth on the African continent. The Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) has been implementing successful measures for structured cooperation with African countries for several years under the *Africa Strategy 2014-2018*.

The BMBF is now launching a second call for the *German-African Innovation Incentive Award* to honour outstanding work by African researchers which has great potential for application. The aim of the measure is to promote the translation of research findings into practical solutions which benefit African societies and improve the living conditions for people in Africa in the longer term. German-African partnerships are an important factor for success in this context.

The award will be presented to an African researcher and his or her respective German cooperation partner. The award will be granted for an existing achievement and will make it possible to develop a follow-up project with which the partners can advance their research findings with a view to future commercial exploitation. The prize money amounts to 150,000 euros.

After the successful first round with four award winners from Africa (Egypt, Kenya, Nigeria and Uganda), a second call has now been published in the Federal Gazette (Bundesanzeiger) on 8 October
